LOCATION AND TIME

The festival takes place on a **Sunday, May 19, 2019 from 11am-4pm at The Land of Medicine Buddha's Stupa meadow and below the 8 Verses Trail**, located at the top of the LMb property, 5800 Prescott Rd, Soquel, CA 95073.

SET-UP AND DISPLAY

You are assigned a white 10'x10' pop up tent or a 10x10 umbrella with a table space. Set up is on Sunday between 9:00am-10:30am. No late set-up is permitted. We furnish no materials or tables. We suggest an overhead canopy for your booth that can be firmly secured to the ground (you are responsible to bring your own booth stakes - Fire Department regulation).

Please submit a photo of space design (including dimensions) with your application. NO BARE TABLES WILL BE ALLOWED. Outdoor spaces are 10'x10'. You are responsible for bringing all your display materials. You have spent a lot of time creating your work and that care should be reflected in your display.

1. EACH PARTICIPANT MUST PROVIDE A VALID SELLER'S PERMIT NUMBER OF HIS/HER APPLICATION. Participants are responsible for collecting their own sales tax.
2. You are responsible for set-up, breakdown, staffing, and cleanup of your booth. **All spaces must be set-up by 10:30am** day of Festival. Please note that although the majority of booth spaces have adjacent drive-up access, some booth spaces will require moving materials across 20 to 40 feet of egress.
3. You are responsible for your own merchandise and its protection.

GENERAL POLICIES

1. We will not accept applications from art and crafts wholesalers or sales representatives. Only quality, personally handcrafted articles are accepted. Prefabricated, imported artwork, kits, store-bought ceramic molds pre-designed material and book-pattern oil painting are not accepted.
Hike4Peace Open House is located at the Land of Medicine Buddha, please be respectful of tenants/ retreat visitors by driving carefully and parking in designated spots. Pets are allowed if child friendly; please bring a leash and potty bag.
2. You are responsible for keeping your area clean. Bring a trash receptacle. Trash cans and bins will be provided throughout the festival park area. Please dispose of your trash properly.
3. Be prepared. There are few shaded areas, ground is not all level and it can be windy and chilly in the morning and evening. Ease with driving a narrow mountain road is

recommended.

Hike4Peace Festival is an open house and it is a fundraiser for our school.
